

ANCHORS AWEIGH! - HAT LEVEL 3

ABOUT THIS PATTERN

Practice your stranded knitting technique with this two-color option based on our popular seafarer's watch cap.

INSTRUCTIONS

Brim:

With MC, cast on 84 stitches. Place marker and join to knit in the round, being careful not to twist.

Work in k2, p2 ribbing for 2".

Hat Body:

Rounds 1-3: Knit around.

Using the chart, knit 16 rounds of the anchor motif. The anchor motif will repeat 6 times around the hat.

With MC, continue knitting in the round until the piece measures approximately 5.5" from the beginning.

Shape Crown:

Note: Switch to dpns when there are too few stitches to knit comfortably on the circular needle.

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MATERIALS

MC (main color):
Approximately 150 yds
worsted weight yarn
CC (contrasting color):
Approximately 20 yds
worsted weight yarn
US size 8 16" circular
needle and set of dpns,
or size needed to get
gauge
Stitch marker
Tapestry needle.

GAUGE

20 sts & 28 rounds = 4 inches square in stockinette stitch

One size, fits adult head.

*K10, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (77 sts) Knit one round.

*K9, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (70 sts) Knit one round

*K8, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (63 sts) Knit one round.

*K7, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (56 sts) Knit one round.

*K6, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (49 sts) Knit one round.

*K5, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (42 sts) Knit one round.

*K4, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (35 sts) Knit one round.

*K3, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (28 sts) Knit one round.

*K2, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (21 sts) Knit one round.

*K1, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round. (14 sts)

K2tog to end of round. 7 sts.

Finishing:

Cut yarn, leaving a tail of 6". With tapestry needle, pull through remaining stitches tightly, secure end on inside. Weave in any ends.

Pat yourself on the back-you've just made a lovely colorwork hat!
