



Seafarer's Scarf

About this Pattern: The original seafarer scarf worn the world over!

Note: The first and last 14 inches of the scarf are knit in garter stitch.

The 18 inches of k4, p4 ribbing in the middle make a narrow-looking neck. This makes the scarf more dense and warmer around the neck without adding extra bulk.

Tip: Slip the first stitch of each row purlwise to keep the edges tidy.

Cast on 32 stitches.

Knit even for 14".

*K4, p4, repeat from * across row for 18".

Knit even for 14".

Finishing: Bind off loosely. Weave in ends.

Skill Level 1:

Finished Measurements: Approximately 6.5" x 46"

Materials: Approximately 300 yards of worsted weight yarn

US size 6 or 7 needles, or size needed to get gauge

Tapestry needle

Gauge: 20 sts & 36 rows = 4 inches square in garter stitch
